Falk Tischendorf was the moderator of a round table meeting with Vasily Osmakov, Deputy Minister of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation, on the topic of amendments to legislation regarding the regulation of special investment contracts (SPIC 2.0)

On 27 September 2019 30 representatives of companies, which are members of the Russian-German Chamber of Foreign Trade, headed by the Chairman of the Board Matthias Schepp, participated in a meeting at the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation with Vasily Osmakov, Deputy Minister of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation.

In the round table meeting moderated by Board Member Falk Tischendorf, the discussion focused on amendments to legislation, which have already entered into force or are currently being developed, regarding the procedure for concluding special investment contracts (SPIC 2.0), and also the expectations of German companies regarding the indicated procedure when implementing investment projects in the Russian Federation. The participants in the round table discussed in particular the requirements on the registration and assessment of cutting-edge technologies, the timeframes for filing applications and the procedure for holding tenders on the conclusion of special investment contracts, and also the correlation of the new and old regulations. Vasily Osmakov noted that the comments of the Russian-German Chamber of Foreign Trade and the position developed jointly with BEITEN BURKHARDT would be taken into account and that the current drafts of the regulatory acts would be submitted soon.
